## Let's forge ahead in unity -Dr. Joseph Essibu urges Central Region NPP

**A**n executive member of the New Patriotic Party (NPP) in the Central Region, Dr Joseph Kobina Essibu, has called on the rank and file of the party in the region to desist from misinformation and forge ahead in unity.

That, he said, was to enable the party to remain solid to retain power in 2024.

Dr Kobina Essibu's call comes in the wake of the simmering disagreements over the allocation of the school feeding programme in the region.

“Anything that does not break us makes us stronger and better.

“Therefore, I join several voices that have heeded to the call for calm among the rank and file of the party in the Central Region amidst the school feeding hot meal fracas,” a statement issued by Dr Essibu said.

### **Allegations**

He said as an executive member of the party he had taken time to follow and ascertain all the issues related to the story and indeed “I can conclude that the allegations by Mr Joe Donkor, a former Central Regional First Vice Chairman and Regional NADMO Director, against the

It said the steps by Mr Donkor to engage the media by broadcasting a purported audio recording of Miss Khadijah Anderson without recourse to the chairman, Kutin, maligned the integrity of the party and left much to be desired.

“I would, therefore, use this medium to impress upon Mr Donkor to apologise to the rank and file of the party, especially chairman Kutin, for not seeking the facts first before his public pronouncement”.

### **Facts**

The facts indicated that Mr Kutin Jr had nothing to do with school feeding in the region or any part of the country.

It said it was common knowledge that the unfortunate attempts to smear the legacy of Chairman Kutin emanated from certain recalcitrant individuals in the party who would stop at nothing to see chaos in the region.

“Miss Khadijah has openly stated that she never levelled allegations against Chairman Kutin for receiving money through an MTN Merchant Number meant for caterers of school feeding in the region, and that the said audio recording was doctored.

### **Committee**

The statement proposed for a committee to be set up by the regional minister to address the differences and engage all stakeholders on the matter.

## Hyundai, KIA to establish assembly plants in Ghana in 2022

South Korean Automobile giants, Hyundai and Kia are the latest to announce their intentions to set up assembling plants in the country by the end of next year 2022.

This follows the Ghana Automotive Development Programme which is being led by the Ghanaian government and some global players.

Minister for Trade and Industry, Alan Kyerematen announced to the German Corporation and other diplomats from the German Embassy at a meeting to sign a 540,000 euros grant for the establishment of an auto desk at the ministry and development of some selected industrial parks in the country.

“By the end of 2022, the Ghana Automotive Development Programme will lead to the establishment of four assembly plants; there will be some leading global auto manufacturing companies including Toyota-Suzuki, Nissan, Kia and Hyundai in addition to the current vehicle assembly operations of Kantanka Automobile Limited, Volkswagen and Sinotruck” he disclosed.

He commended the German Government, noting that cooperation through the special initiative would support the One-Stop Automotive Programme Management Unit which coordinates the implementation of the Ghana Automotive Development Programme and serve as a One-Stop-Centre for auto assembly companies and other stakeholders in the auto industry.

This include component and parts manufacturers, dealerships, and other companies interested in participating in the industry.

“It will receive and evaluate applications and investment plans from auto assembly and component manufacturing companies in Ghana,” he explained.

A state-of-the-art training centre for technology and skills transfer will also be established to help build a competent labour force for the various specializations in the automotive sector.


