NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE NEW PATRIOTIC PARTY TO VOTE ON SATURDAY TO BREAK THE TIE IN THE SPECIAL ELECTORAL COLLEGE ELECTIONS

The National Council of the New Patriotic Party (NPP) shall, on Saturday, 2nd September, 2023, constitute an Electoral College to vote in a special election to break the tie between the 5th placed candidates in the just ended Special Electoral College election held on 26th August, 2023, in the persons of Hon. Ing. Francis Addai Nimo and Hon. Boakye Kyerematen Agyarko.

This decision was taken by the Party at a National Council meeting held on Wednesday, 30th August, 2023, in pursuance of the provisions of Articles 10(3)(1) and 18 of the NPP Constitution having regard to the supreme interest and wellbeing of the Party.

The special election shall be conducted by the Electoral Commission of Ghana under the supervision of the Presidential Elections Committee, at the Party Headquarters, Asylum Down, Accra.

By this decision, the National Council, which is the second highest decision-making body of the Party, has varied Regulation 25 of the revised guidelines published by the Presidential Elections Committee on the conduct of the Special Electoral College election in respect of the procedure for breaking a tie for the 5th placed candidates.

The National Council also overruled Regulation 27 of the published guidelines, which barred government appointees and party executives/delegates from acting as polling agents for any aspiring presidential candidate. Consequently, a candidate is entitled to appoint any member of the Party to serve as his polling agent in the ensuing elections.

Notice is accordingly served to all stakeholders and to the general public.
